Predictions for 2018, include it will be the year where drones will be used to deliver postal items and help with law enforcement.

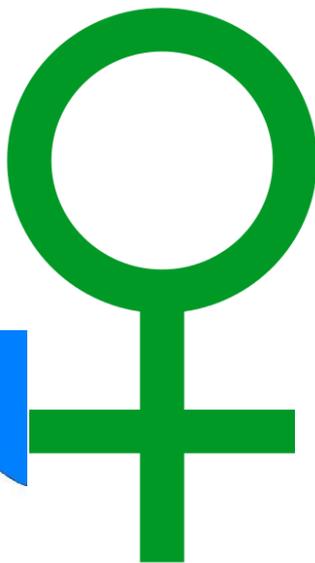
Also 2018 will be a year of political turmoil and environmental crisis caused by dramatic and unprecedented weather.

THE YEAR OF THE WSEC



Make double of this essential pasta sauce and freeze half for a rainy day

ingredients

- Low calorie cooking spray
- 500g 5% or less minced beef
- 1 onion, roughly chopped
- 1 large carrot, peeled and diced
- 3 celery sticks, roughly chopped
- 4 garlic cloves, roughly chopped
- 400g can chopped tomatoes
- 4 tbsp tomato purée
- 500g passata
- 1 tsp dried mixed herbs
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper
- Small handful of finely chopped fresh parsley, to garnish

method

Spray a large non-stick frying pan with low calorie cooking spray and place over a high heat

Add the Quorn and stir-fry for 2 minutes or until browned, then add the onion, carrot, celery and garlic and stir-fry for 1 minute

Add the chopped tomatoes, tomato purée, passata and dried herbs, season well and cook over a medium heat for 12-15 minutes, stirring occasionally.

Stir the Bolognese into your favourite pasta and serve hot, with parsley scattered over.
