Free University Brighton

The Brighton Free University (BFU) was set up by Ali Ghanimi, in 2012, when the then coalition government trebled the university fees and cut higher and adult education. It was in



the public outrage and student demonstrations, Ali thought of how he could run a community led alternative education system.

Since the conception they have indeed managed to have an alternative education system that is free. This is achieved by volunteer tutors and the use free public spaces around Brighton, such as community centres, cafes, libraries etc. There are no tuition or enrolment fees whatsoever, even for their degree-level courses.

As a legal quirk, they are not allowed to award degrees as only long established, conventional universities are given that right – but their degree-level courses are externally validated by independent assessors in exactly the same way as conventional universities are. They currently have around 150 people taking our degree-level "freegrees" courses and have provided education events to thousands more since they were established. As the FUB is a cooperative it's the students who collectively get to decide their own educational journey and have an equal say in how FUB is run.

The FUB runs the most diverse range of education events you can imagine. They have academic lectures in Philosophy, Criminology and Sociology, a women's DIY group workshop on building shelves, a course on Non-violent Communication, a yoga drop-in, a Middle East history talk, a film about communities who are creating solutions to human crises and a workshop for people who are thinking about changing career.

FUB is more than education and the many benefits of that, it's also about building communities, bringing diverse people together and trying to empower them to affect change. Although there are a few other free universities in the UK, they are unique in terms of the scale and what they provide.

This provider gives live tuition over the internet, which allows more convenience than regular lessons, with online tutors, by using Skype, Google Hangouts or Zoom. This means that they can reach anywhere there is an internet connection.

A History of Public Health on Post-War Britain


