Genealogy

Congratulations for making it through the election and now you're excited/dreading the future ahead, but we would like to give you another opportunity, instead of looking forwards, to look backwards and glimpse the days gone by.

We will be calling at the two Openreach centre's of excellence, in Withdean and Sevenoaks (see dates below). In the lunch period we will let you have a look at the following:

So what do you need to know before you come? What would be best is to have knowledge of a relative who was born before 1911 and roughly where, but failing that someone who was alive in 1939 but no longer alive. You can still find information even if you don't have the above information, but its going to be a lot harder. Unfortunately in the search for ancestors with common names ie "Smith", you need to know more information than those with uncommon names ie "Raynot".

If you have wondered at what a Genealogy DNA test result looks like, we can show you. There are many places which now offer these tests, do you know what to look for?

• Winner £75 prize


• **Second** £50 prize

There are 5 categories this year and they are as follows:

Action

This photo has to show some action, whether mechanical or person, but it would have to portray some sort of movement. This could include sports, children playing and people working.



This photo would depict comradery or friendship, so the photograph would show 2 or more people (could include animals) either helping or just enjoying each other. Could even show a celebration.

Colour

Whatever the picture is this category has to be colourful. Either a colourful scene or perhaps you can use some photo manipulation to add colour to a black and white photo.

Emotions

This can be a person/people or event that shows emotions. Think along the lines of joy, sadness, rage, pride, love etc.

Street Life

Any street view showing life in the street, whether it be a classic car parked, people gathering, pavement artists and people using street furniture are just a few ideas.
