Ancestry – Case Study

A few years ago, I recanted a story of a bad boy that I found in my family tree, who was perpetually being put into gaol. Well recently I found one that was transported to Tasmania.


A brother of one of my direct ancestors, by the name of Israel Shipley, got involved with a gang of ne'er do wells and got involved with a burglary. The burglary, in 1844, was witnessed by a police man, who ended up being shot and killed. All three involved with the shooting was sentenced to death by hanging.

Perhaps you might say, he deserved it, but from reading the newspaper articles it was not as clear cut as it would seem as many upstanding members of the community petitioned the government to free the men. The local people had reason to doubt the validity of the only witness, and what she was doing at the time with the policeman.

The leader of the group was hanged but Israel and his other friend had their sentence commuted to transportation to Van Diemens Land (Tasmania).

He moved to Norfolk Island and South Queensland, and was finally pardoned in 1857. His wife, in expectancy or social embarrassment, declared herself a widow in 1851! What happened to Israel after his pardon, is an investigation for a later date.
